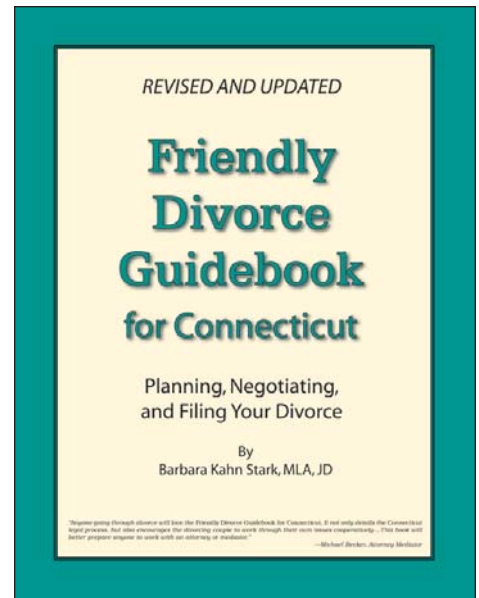


Going Through A Divorce?
